- 4.1 Fish & Wildlife (Adam Mirus / Darren McInnis) N/A
- 4.2 RCMP-Olds (S/Sgt Jim MacDonald) Sgt. MacDonald described Olds RCMP Annual Performance Plan April 1 March 31. 1. PROPERTY CRIME REDUCTION by 10%. 2017-18 there was a significant reduction achieved but for this year the trend has reversed and it has increased significantly. Targeting prolific offenders and working closely with the RCMP Crime Reduction Units. Also utilizing BAIT equipment and GPS tracking. 2. EMPLOYEE WELLNESS. 3. COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENTS. Charity Checkstop / Events at schools / Chamber joint event./ monthly RCW meetings, etc. 4. TRAFFIC SAFETY. Speed / Distracted Driving (NOTE Some Insurance Companies will cancel your insurance or triple premiums for Distracted Driving Tickets). 5. REPORTING SUSPICIOUS ACTIVITY. When these reports come in they are now considered top priority and several arrests have been accomplished due to vigilant public. The 3 detachments work closely together and have a high clearance record. The APP's are similar with Didsbury & Sundre too.
- 4.3 RCMP -Sundre (Cst. Jared Hamilton) (Cst. Jared Hamilton) Also liaison with Sundre COP and work cooperatively. Working with RCMP staticians to help with fact that Sundre

detachment area is #2 in B & E's in District. Oilfield losses were close to \$150,000 and some sites were hit multiple times for copper thefts / equipment / , etc. But businesses aren't taking proactive measures to combat. Recyclers ARE required to document sellers but this doesn't seem to deter enough.

- 4.4 RCMP Didsbury (Cpl. R Organ) Same experience as Olds & Sundre. AND PLEASE CALL WITH ANY SUSPICIOUS INCIDENTS. Frauds continue to be an issue. NOW Scammers are sending letters as people are told not to accept calls or e-mails. Check any message out by calling the phone number on the back of your card. NOT one send on letter or e-mail. Make sure your call is disconnected so someone can't ghost the number.
- 4.5 MOUNTAIN VIEW COUNTY (Kevin Heppler / Duncan Milne) 2019 Bylaw complaints up Traffic tickets up. Lots of +50 over speed limit. At +51 over a mandatory court appearance is required. 1 drilling rig in Eagle Hill area. Distracted Driving Fines in Sask \$580 Ontario \$1,000.
- 4.6 RED DEER COUNTY REPORT: (Officer Brad Olsen) Multiple distracted driving tickets given in gasoline alley area. +50 over speed also similar experience. 1100 files for 2019. 5 Detachments in Red Deer County. Communicate closely with Lacombe police. 3300 tickets last year 7000 warnings. In May will work with Fish & Wildlife on lake patrols. Also do Drive at Home program for good drivers.
