- 4.2 RCMP-Olds (Cst. Gary Sandu/ S/Sgt Jim MacDonald) Crime issues in area include a 30% increase in property crime. Thieves are targeting pick up trucks to use for other crimes. Cst. Sandhu commented on the WhatsApp used by COP. It uses data to communicate between cell phones. Can send pictures. Live communication. RD Lacombe County looking to use encrypted to group. Olds detachment is expecting new recruit. 1 on maternity leave 1 back from paternity leave. Down 2 with leaves. But better with S/Sgt position filled. COP now up and running. Encouraging community to be more observant and get to know your neighbors!! ACCOPA website has standard reporting forms.

- 4.5 Mountain View County (Kevin Heppler / Duncan Milne). Kevin reported activity is quiet right now drilling wise but there is a pipeline going in around Sundre. Duncan reported there are 3 new councillors on council now after the election. Tony Martins has retired and Jeff Holmes took his position. County is facing a reduction in taxes close to \$2M with the slowdown in the oil industry. They had to write-off \$241,000 in taxes, some may be recoverable. Master Agreements with towns being negotiated and signed. Looking at Enhanced Policing position for County. But shortfall in available officers makes this hard to fill. 240 RCMP positions are currently unfilled. Carstairs town currently funds one enhanced position. Sundre is looking to increase office help. Mail box thefts surfacing again.
- 4.6 PRESIDENT's REPORT Prov RCW has signed a Memorandum of Understanding with the RCMP, COP mandate is to do active patrols. RCW is to do passive patrols. But ALL suspicious activity should be reported. New K-Division commander is pushing to address rural crime. Creating Crime Detection Units for prolific offenders. Every district in Province to get one. Minor complaints to be dealt with through call centers, usually over phone to reduce police time on paperwork. Pockets of criminals responsible for majority of crimes. Strategy of building partnerships is current practice with Sol General office / COP / Crime Stoppers, and other crime prevention groups. Prov. Association teaming up with Central AB Crime Prevention unit in Red Deer for office space / support. Also creating a training video on RCW that can be shared with new RCMP cadets.
