PRESENTATION: CRIME PREVENTION THROUGH ENVIRONMENTAL DESIGN:

Officer Stephen Poburan, Red Deer County

HIGHLIGHT POINTS: Purpose of CPTED is to make your property less attractive to thieves by increasing the effort required to steal it, and increase risk of being caught thus reducing the rewards value. Remove any legally accepted excuses for trespassing – assist local law enforcement by identifying potential offenders.

PRINCIPLES: Natural Surveillance. Clear sight-line / visibility / lighting. Crop trees 4' up from base

Access Control – consider adversarial bushes like Hawthorn or Roses by lower windows.

Territorial Reinforcement – sense of ownership – fencing / signage

Maintenance - sense of pride Broken Window theory Target Hardening - locks / surveillance systems

What attracts thieves? – Anything of Value, electronics, etc.

OTHER CONSIDERATIONS: Where do you park your vehicle? Where are your keys stored? Number of entry – exit points on property? Lighting? Who is monitoring your security system? Can your neighbors see your property? What do you post on Social Media?

ASSESSMENTS & RECOMMENDATIONS. Olds RCMP have 2 Auxiliary Officers that can do assessments. Red Deer County has officers as well.
