Increase in crime is affecting premiums and companies are getting stickier on who they will insure. There is a B & E every 2.5 hours in Calgary. Most popular item – F250 or 350. Some companies require \$1,000 deductible. Also increases in claims and fraudulent claims. Auto rates are controlled by prov. government . Property coverage rates based on postal codes. Water based claims now #1 claim. 30% of drivers admit to using cell phones while driving. New vehicle windshields now have multiple sensors in them and are expensive. FRAUDS: Purposeful accidents & claims for soft tissue injury - \$\$. Rear-end crashes – vehicle in back is deemed liable. Some companies have discounts for vehicle immobilizers or tracking devices.

Farm & acreage market – bestselling – driveway alarms with sensors and video. Good quality locks ad hardware are best investments!! Lighting is a good deterrent.
