



Didsbury Annual Performance Plan 2014/2015

Final Progress (April 1st – March 31st).

Priorities were chosen based on the feedback received from area communities policed by the Didsbury RCMP for the 2014/2015 year. The following results are generated based on our activities within the detachment's entire area of jurisdiction.

1. **Priority - Community Visibility**
 - a. Annual goal set of 250 Patrols to Cremona – **229 completed**
 - b. Goal set of 500 combined Bar Walks/Foot Patrols/School Visits and School Zone Patrols – **437 completed (113 bar walks, 44 foot patrols, 82 School visits, 198 School zone patrols)**
2. **Priority - Contribute to Safe Roads**
 - a. Annual goal of 400 Speed/Intersection/Seatbelt tickets or warnings – **216 completed**
 - b. Annual goal of 10 checkstops or Joint Force Operations with area Peace Officers - **14 completed**
3. **Priority - Reduce the Abuse of Drugs**
 - a. Annual goal of 40 drug charges or warning – **29 (16 charges, 13 scored as “cleared other”)**
 - b. Annual goal of 15 drug presentations in area schools (including DARE in Carstairs via the Carstairs enhanced member). – **19 completed**

Given the resource challenges as experienced through much of the fiscal year, pro-active efforts toward our community priorities were strong and the overall plan was a success.

Regional Annual Performance Plan (APP) 2015/2016:

Based on feedback from all area communities over the last two months, the top three priorities for our jurisdiction have been updated. Based on our community consultations and discussions with members the focus and goals for some of the initiatives have also been updated as follows:

1. **Priority - Community Visibility**
 - a. Annual goal remains at 250 Patrols to Cremona.
 - b. Goal remains of 500 combined Bar Walks/Foot Patrols/School Visits and School Patrols.
 - c. New goal of increased media presence with a target of 15 crime specific photo opportunities in the news (search warrant results, drug seizures etc).
2. **Priority - Contribute to Safe Roads**
 - a. Annual goal remains 400 Speed/Intersection/Seatbelt tickets or warnings.
 - b. Annual goal of 10 Checkstops or Joint Force Operations with area Peace Officers.
3. **Priority – Crime Reduction**
 - a. New goal of reducing Property Crime by 5 % (from 527 to 500). Goals will be achieved by:

- i. 20 Crime Reduction Presentations.
 - ii. Creation of Habitual Offender Program with at least 2 habitual offenders being tracked.
 - iii. Creation of Suppression Team. This team will target both property crimes and drugs.
