

DIDSBURY RCMP CRIME REPORT – AUGUST 13, 2015

INCIDENTS:

1. AUGUST 11, 2015 – Theft of Clothing from ULLA-LA in Didsbury. Middle-aged female stole 3 outfits worth over \$100 by taking off the security beepers. **SEE ATTACHED SURVEILLANCE PICTURES.**
2. AUGUST 9, 2015 – midnight. Theft from vehicle from Carstairs Village Green. Black Leather Purse with silver magnet stole from unlocked vehicle
3. AUGUST 7, 2015 – Theft of unlocked '94 Black Dodge Dakota License: ZUF 417. From rural area near RR 271. Vehicle was hooked to trailer that was unhooked and left behind.
4. AUGUST 10, 2015 – 7:15 am. A 2008 Black Dodge Ram with keys inside – Plate DD 6159. taken from area on HWY 766. Male driving a newer white F truck appeared to be together with suspect. A firearm was in the stolen truck.
5. AUGUST 11, 2015 – overnight. 2005 White GMC Sierra – Plate EFE 938 was stolen from RR 15. Keys and wallet were inside.
6. AUGUST 7, 2015 – Gas & Dash in Didsbury from Centax. Black SUV with trailer and plate covered in mud.
7. AUGUST 11, 2015 – Gas & Dash in Didsbury from Didsbury Esso. White Chev sedan - \$20.
8. AUGUST 10, 2015 - 7 am. A number of scratch lottery tickets were stolen from Centax, Didsbury.
9. AUGUST 10, 2015 – 6:30 overnight. Mischief to vehicle on Goddard Crescent, Carstairs. Vehicle entered and glove box rummaged through. Left radar detector behind.
10. AUGUST 10 – 11, 2015 – Vandalism to Chrysler 200 on Geoff Road, Carstairs. Front and rear tire slashed.
11. AUGUST 10 2015 – overnight. Didsbury – Wallet stolen from vehicle.
12. AUGUST 10 2015 – Julia Place, Didsbury – fence damaged.
13. AUGUST 09, 2015 – Overnight. Mackenzie Way, Carstairs – vehicle broken into and sunglasses, cash and wallet stolen.
14. AUGUST 8, 2015 – afternoon – overnight. Vehicle on 23rd Ave, Didsbury accessed through unlocked doors.
15. AUGUST 6 – 11, 2015. Burnt Timber Gas Plant broke into , Nothing noted as missing,
16. AUGUST 6, 2015 – 10:30 pm – 6:00 am – Hwy 549 – B & E. Front door knocked down. Jewellery stolen.
17. Couple of weeks ago resident left for holiday and had new washer & dryer stolen
18. AUGUST 4 - 8, 2015 – RR 52 B & E to residence. Front door pryed open. Jewellery stolen – left electronics and guns.
19. AUGUST 10, 2015 – During the day in Didsbury. B & E – forced entry to rear entrance door,. Electronics stolen. Entire basement ransacked.

Valuable & costume Jewellery both targeted.

RCMP are encouraging anyone with information on these incidents to contact them or Crime Stoppers. Thieves are OPPORTUNISTS! **Please lock vehicles and buildings**– this cannot be stressed enough!! Also please report all incidents even if it appears nothing has been stolen. Call and report vehicles left parked in fields or driveway accesses for several days – they may be stolen or abandoned vehicles. And if you see a suspicious vehicle – please try to get license plate but do not confront the suspect or put yourself in danger. Take a picture with your phone if you can. **TIP:** Driveway alarms alerting you to when someone drives in are very beneficial as are trail cameras. Targeting electronics, Ford pick-ups – 150, 250, 350 and welding equipment. TIP – if you are going to a special event – birthday party, Xmas party. Post the information on Facebook **AFTER THE EVENT – DON'T ADVERTISE THAT YOUR PLACE WILL BE VACANT.** Most thieves are using trucks (and possibly trailers) and are prowling the early morning hours looking for targets. If you see an unknown vehicle driving around your neighbourhood – get description, license and picture if possible.
