

Didsbury RCMP Report – July 18 & 19, 2015

2015-07-18

- Theft of vehicle from Didsbury Inn parking lot
 - Happened in early morning hours.
 - Vehicle recovered abandoned next day by Innisfail RCMP.

2015-07-19

- Break & Enter to residence on Centre Street in Carstairs. Occurred at 4 am.
 - Garage door was left unlocked. Unknown suspects entered garage and rummaged through car.
 - Complainant caught suspect in act and suspects then fled on foot.
 - Loose change and a pair of sunglasses stolen.
- RCMP member doing routine patrol near Barley's Pub in Carstairs at 2:30 am.
 - RCMP noted a truck hauling travel trailer, and then the travel trailer came unhooked from the truck and hit the pavement. Suspect(s) driving truck then fled on foot and mingled into closing crowd outside Barley's Pub. Unable to determine who was driving truck.
 - Truck was a 2015 F-350, previously stolen from Drayton Valley. Trailer was stolen from Carstairs. Licence plate on truck was stolen from Olds.
- Theft from truck outside West Highland Crescent in Carstairs
 - Sometime overnight, toolbox was rummaged through & numerous tools were stolen.
 - Toolbox was unlocked. No witnesses/suspects.
- Break & Enter at JD's Bar in Didsbury.
 - Occurred sometime overnight. Large rock was thrown through glass door. Suspect(s) gained entry and proceeded throughout business. Unknown at this time what was stolen. File currently being investigated.
- Theft of vehicle from West Highlands Crescent in Carstairs
 - Occurred in early morning hours.
 - 2010 Dodge Ram 2500 series stolen. Licence plate BBD 3581. Grey in colour.
- Theft of vehicle from 15th Avenue in Carstairs
 - Occurred in early morning hours
 - Vehicle was parked outside residence with keys inside.
 - 2000 Toyota Celica, white in colour. No licence plate on vehicle.
 - Calgary Police Service called the next day to advise they had recovered the vehicle in Calgary.
