

Some info from the Innisfail RCMP & Raven Rural Crime Watch

Early in the morning of the 19th, Innisfail RCMP Members responded to multiple calls of break enter and theft to the rural area. In one instance, a member of the public called police immediately upon observing a suspicious male in the area of his residence. Members responded and were able to locate one female and a vehicle which contained property which was stolen from earlier in the day. One male was able to evade capture and was last seen walking on the C and E Trail near the Daines Rodeo Grounds. Described as a Caucasian male wearing a dark top with white lettering on it, and dark green pants.
