Each of our local RCMP Detachments have had some real successes in apprehending some of the prolific offenders operating in our area lately, and have recovered a significant amount of property and drugs. Again a reminder to mark your property so that if it is recovered you can claim it.

Last week, the Didsbury Detachment was successful in apprehending William Govan, (born in 1982) from Grande Prairie, and have charged him with multiple offenses of thefts and possession of stolen property and domestic offenses. He is in custody awaiting trial.

Vehicle thefts and break-ins to vehicles are on the rise again. Police thank the public for reporting suspicious activities and encourage you to call any unusual incidents in immediately to dispatch at 403-556-3323.
