

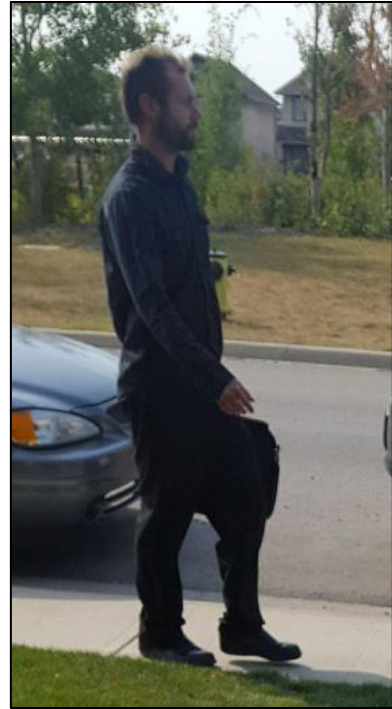
Via Ponoka RCW - Heads up if selling

PLEASE SHARE!

This guy came to purchase our Denali for sale yesterday. He made everything seem 100% legit and brought a bank draft for the full \$18,500.00. Unbeknownst to him I work at a law firm and see bank drafts every single day. This one was produced from the Bank of Montreal in McKenzie Towne. It was grey. All Bank of Montreal bank drafts are BLUE. Wayne refused to let the truck go because he couldn't produce his driver's license. We followed up with the Bank of Montreal and they confirmed that it was fraudulently produced.



PLEASE everyone be cautious when selling on Kijiji or any other public venue. He was using a Northern Alberta telephone number as well.
