

Cocaine, Cash, stolen firearms from Sylvan Lake Homes From Red Deer/Lacombe Rural Crime Watch

Three people have been arrested after cocaine, cash, and a stolen firearm were seized this morning from two homes in Sylvan Lake.

It was at about 8:00 AM when officers from Sylvan Lake, Red Deer RCMP, and the Red Deer Dog Services executed search warrants at residences on 42 Street and 51 Street in Sylvan Lake following a month long drug trafficking investigation.

Priority Task Force seized cocaine, cash and a rifle that been stolen out of Strathcona County and took two men and one woman into custody without incident.

RCMP will issue an update with more details of the items seized, names of the accused and the charges laid once those charges have been sworn before the courts.

The Priority Task Force is made up of members from Red Deer RCMP General Investigative Section (GIS), Sylvan Lake, Innisfail, Blackfalds, Ponoka, Rimbey and Rocky Mtn House RCMP detachments and Lacombe Police Services. The Task Force is committed to increased interagency communication, shared criminal intelligence and a strategic focus on prolific property crime offenders in keeping with the "K" division emphasis on crime reduction strategies.
