The Blackfalds RCMP often gets asked when do you call 911? The answer being for the most part simple:

- 911 is for Police, Fire, or Medical Emergencies when immediate action is required. Someone's health, safety or property is in imminent jeopardy or a crime is in progress.
- 911 should be called for any life - threatening emergency, any crime in progress or for impaired drivers.
