

## Airdrie Rural RCMP Want to Know if You Recognize These Thieves

Airdrie Rural RCMP are asking for the public's assistance in identifying a male and female responsible for a residential break and enter and theft that occurred back in July in Rocky View County.

On July 26th, 2018 at approximately 10:39 am, a stolen black Hyundai car arrived at a rural residence located along Township Road 260 in Rocky View County. Video surveillance on the property showed a female exit the car and knock on the door of the residence. She then returned to the vehicle and a male driver exits the car and approaches the residence and knocks. Both suspects then returned to the vehicle and donned gloves, hats, and jackets.


The male used a small crowbar to force open the front door of the residence. Both are then observed entering the home. The female is seen leaving the home with numerous stolen items. Both later flee the rural property.

The female suspect is described as:

- Caucasian female with brown hair and a medium build
- Wearing a white tank top, denim jeans, white sneakers, dark sunglasses and a lanyard around her neck
- Later placed a fitted coat on with a black hat and dark gloves

The male suspect is described as:

- Caucasian male with short brown hair and a thin build
- Wearing a beige coat, grey shirt, denim jeans, black sneakers and dark sunglasses
