

# Airdrie RCMP Requesting Assistance to Identify Male Using Stolen Banking Card

On Sunday, August 6, 2017 at approximately 2:00 am, an unknown male used a stolen ATB debit card at Fas Gas Plus on Main Street in Airdrie.

The stolen debit card was used to make three separate, small value purchases using the tap function. The ATB debit card had been stolen from a vehicle overnight in the Woodside of Airdrie on the same date.

The male is described as:

- Caucasian
- Slim Build, thin face
- Approximately 30 years of age
- Short dirty blonde hair
- Unshaven look with dark stubble on face
- Wearing a dark, fitted jacket with hood, and dark jeans
- arrived at Fas Gas in a red 4 door small car, unknown license plate

The same stolen ATB debit card was used a few hours later at a 7-11 located in Red Deer.
