

## Airdrie RCMP Requesting Assistance with Credit Card Fraud

Airdrie RCMP are asking the public for information to help identify a male suspect responsible for using a stolen credit card to make a large purchase at Shoppers Drug Mart on Market Street in Airdrie.

On Tuesday, June 27, 2017, at approximately 12:00 pm, an unknown male, entered Shoppers Drug Mart and purchased approximately \$800 worth of prepaid Canada Post envelopes with a stolen credit card. A photograph of the male was obtained as he left the store on foot.



The male suspect is described as:

- Caucasian
- Tall and stocky build with dark hair
- Wearing a black hat and black t-shirt

Anyone with information on this occurrence or who can help identify the suspect is asked to contact Constable Simon Desbiens at the Airdrie RCMP Detachment at (403) 945-7200.
