

Airdrie RCMP seek to identify theft suspects

The Airdrie RCMP are asking for information to help locate the individuals responsible for thefts from vehicles in an underground parking lot at the McKenzie Way apartment complex on October 22.

On October 22 at 11:47 pm, a man entered the front door of the 2000 block of 104 McKenzie Way SW then went to the underground parking lot and opened the garage door, letting in a Dodge Ram truck. Several parked vehicles were entered and contents of the vehicles were stolen. The truck was captured on video surveillance and was seen to leave again at 12:12 am on October 23.
