

Airdrie RCMP and Calgary Police Service Arrest Male in Stolen Truck Containing Explosive Device

The Airdrie Rural RCMP have assisted the Calgary Police Service (CPS) in arresting a Calgary male in a stolen truck at Cross Iron Mills Mall. The truck was found to contain what resembled an explosive device.

On May 14, 2018 at approximately 4:15 pm, Airdrie Rural RCMP assisted CPS HAWCS and CPS officers locate a male driving a stolen Dodge Ram truck into the Cross Iron Mills Mall parking lot. The male was arrested by CPS officers outside of the mall without incident.

A search of the stolen Dodge Ram truck resulted in the finding of what appeared to be an explosive device. Alberta RCMP's Explosive Disposal Unit (EDU) was deployed to assist. The "smoke-type canister" was disposed of by EDU without any danger to the public.

29-year-old, Justin Gordon Denison of Calgary, has been charged with:

- Possession of stolen property over \$5000 – 2 counts
- Possession of stolen property under \$5000
- Driving while suspended
- Mischief to property
- Breach of Recognizance – 2 counts
- Possession of break and enter tools
- Driving an uninsured motor vehicle
- Failing to comply with court order – 2 counts
