

## Airdrie RCMP Looking to Identify Male Using Stolen Credit Cards

The Airdrie RCMP are looking for assistance to identify a male using stolen credit cards at a gas station in Airdrie back in March.

On March 18, 2018, an unknown male entered an unlocked vehicle parked along Morningside Court. The vehicle contained bank and credit cards which were then used at numerous locations within Airdrie and Calgary. The stolen credit cards were used to purchase over \$400 of goods from gas stations in a short period of time.

A photo of the male suspect taken from the Petro-Canada gas station located at 800 Yankee Valley Boulevard is being released to the public in hopes that someone may be able to identify him.



The Airdrie RCMP would also like to take this time to remind the public to “Lock It or Lose It”. Following three simple steps will go a long way to help with crime prevention within our community:

- Remove the keys
- Hide or remove all valuables
- And LOCK IT UP!
