

## **Beiseker RCMP are seeking public assistance in theft of ATM**

*April 20, 2016*

Beiseker, Alberta - Beiseker RCMP is investigating an ATM theft from the Mountain View Credit Union in Linden, AB. At approximately 3:00 AM on April 20. Three males were observed entering the Mountain View Credit Union, and using chains attached to a truck they were able to remove the secured ATM from the building.

The suspect vehicle is described as a light coloured Ford F-350 was seen dragging the ATM east on Township 304 leaving a trail of debris on the road.

At 3:30am, Beiseker RCMP along Airdrie Rural RCMP and Three Hills RCMP with Linden Fire Department were called to the scene of a vehicle fire on Township 304 and 253 Range Road.

On arrival, police determine this was the same vehicle involved in the ATM theft in Linden.

The fire was extinguished by Linden Fire Department

The ATM was located along the road in the vicinity of the vehicle fire.

A suspicious vehicle reported earlier in the night may also be related. The truck described as a dark blue 2011 Chevrolet Silverado, may be travelling with an attached trailer described as a flat deck with sides and a burnt out tail light.
