

Beiseker RCMP - Assistance to identify suspect

RCMP from Beiseker detachment are asking for the public's assistance to identify a suspect in a break and enter to a residence and fraudulent use of credit cards.

In January 2018, a home on a rural property near Beiseker was broken into. Suspects stole jewellery, including family heirlooms, and credit cards from the home. A short time later, the stolen credit cards were used to make purchases at an Airdrie gas station and pharmacy.

Investigators are asking for the public's help to identify a female suspect seen on surveillance using the cards.
