

## **Beiseker RCMP respond to motor vehicle theft from residence – UPDATE**

As a result of continued and extensive investigation, the RCMP have suspect photos to release, and have linked the previously reported July 28 theft to a similar theft which occurred at the same residence on July 22, 2018.

At 6:00 a.m. on July 22, a homeowner noticed that unknown suspects broke into a residential garage and stole a 2016 Dodge Challenger from the garage. During this theft, suspects made off with several keys including the vehicle keys to the Dodge 3500 truck, which was stolen on July 28.

A red Kia Sportage was observed during both incidents, and the Beiseker RCMP have determined that both thefts are associated.

Beiseker RCMP continue to work collaboratively with the Southern Alberta District Crime Reduction Unit and RCMP Auto Theft Section in order to further this investigation.

The RCMP were able to obtain surveillance of the suspects from the July 22, incident from various locations including Cochrane and Airdrie. As well, a surveillance photo of the suspect with the suspect Kia was obtained in the July 28 incident. (photos are attached).
