

Cochrane RCMP Charge Two Following Fraud Investigations

On August 19th, 2016, members from the Cochrane RCMP were able to successfully arrest and charge a male and female after a number of fraud complaints.

RCMP identified Kristin STEVENSON and Taylor IRVINE when they had used a stolen credit card to obtain merchandise from various businesses around Cochrane. The two were located at one of the businesses and arrested without incident.

30 year old Kristin STEVENSON and 34 year old Taylor IRVINE were both charged with three counts of Fraud under \$5000 as well as one count of Theft under \$5000 for an incident that had been under investigation since July. IRVINE was also charged with Assault.

IRVINE was released to appear in court on October 4th 2016 while STEVENSON remains in custody to appear in court on August 26th 2016.
