

Cochrane RCMP - Attempted Break and Enter into rural residence

On July 18th, 2017 at approximately 5:00 am the Cochrane RCMP were advised of an attempted Break and Enter into a residence in the rural Woodland area. The suspect departed the area, without gaining entry, in an unknown direction. Attached are photos of the suspect in this attempted Break and Enter.



Approximately 1 hour later there was a theft from motor vehicle, also in the Woodland area. In this occurrence the homeowner heard his vehicle windows being smashed and arrived at his vehicle just as two males were fleeing in a black dodge truck, last seen heading southbound from the Woodland area. It is not known at this time if these two occurrences are related.
