

UPDATE: Numerous Charges for 'Chop Shop' Operation

At the conclusion of the search warrant the following 3 people have been charged and charges are pending against a fourth person:

- Aldina Snow (33) of Morley has been charged with one count of being in possession of property obtained by crime over \$5000, one count of resist/obstruct a police officer, two counts of unsafe storage of firearms, four counts of unauthorized possession of a firearm, plus three additional charges. Snow has been remanded and is scheduled to appear in Cochrane Court on March 27, 2018.
- Stacey House (44) of Morley has been charged with one count of unsafe storage of a firearm, one count of unauthorized possession of a firearm and one count of resist/obstruct a police officer. House is scheduled to appear in Cochrane Court on April 3, 2018.
- Mackenzie Twoyoungmen (24) of Morley has been charged with one count of being in possession of property obtained by crime under \$5000, one count of unauthorized possession of a firearm, one count of careless use of a firearms and two counts of failing to comply with conditions. Twoyoungmen has been remanded and is next scheduled to appear in Cochrane Court on March 27, 2018.
