On March 4, 2016 Olds RCMP conducted a Targeted Enforcement Operation in the Town of Olds on Distracted Drivers. 28 traffic stops were initiated by participating members with 30 charges being issued totalling about \$9000.00 in fines.

Individual offences for Distracted driving bear a \$287.00 specified penalty and 3 demerit points. Distracted driving includes using a hand held phone while talking, texting or e-mailing, operating electronic devices (ie lap top, dvd player), manually programming GPS devices or audio players (MP3), reading, writing and personal grooming.

It has been noted that drivers are holding their cell phone while using the speaker phone function believing this to be hands free; however it is not. The phone must be activated by a single touch or be voice activated.

March 1, 2016 officers conducted a lunch time targeted enforcement in area school zones. 10 violators were issued tickets for driving in excess of 30 kph in a school zone.
