

Rural B&Es Innisfail Area

Innisfail RCMP are investigating multiple B&Es on Range Road 45 that have occurred in the past 3 weeks where the border of our two Detachments meet.

We have yet to make an arrest but the same residences and businesses have been hit multiple times and the residents are fearful. They are asking for increased patrols and presence in the area in and around the border.

B&Es are happening between midnight and 0600 hrs.

Current Leads:

- Suspect vehicle 1:
White Dodge dually with a flat deck, BTB involved in multiple B&E - thefts and is believed responsible for the break in to the Hales Lake Rodeo Ground
- A second unidentified vehicle (truck) is possible working with the Dodge dually and acting as a spotter vehicle.
- Suspect Vehicle 2:
Older model (90's) white Chev or GMC pickup with green/teal striping on the side, plate covered by a rag or piece of clothing.

Suspects: Two young males,

1. 6ft+, skinny, wearing dark clothing with hoodie.
2. 5'8", skinny, wearing dark clothing with hoodie.
