

## **Leduc RCMP warn public of fraud happening in Leduc**

Leduc RCMP are investigating two separate frauds in the City of Leduc. It appears the victims received a phone call from a fake bank manager claiming they are trying to catch a dishonest bank employee. The fake manager requested the victim meet them in a parking lot and give them money.

Leduc RCMP are reminding the public the bank would never call someone requesting a meeting in a parking lot to exchange money.
