

Sundre RCMP Investigate Theft of Firearms in Residential Break and Enter

Sundre, Alberta - On Tuesday, Mar. 8, 2016, police responded to the report of a break, enter and theft at a rural residence near the Town of Sundre from which numerous firearms were taken together with jewelry and other items of property, including the pickup truck of the homeowner.

Investigators have been able to confirm that approximately 35 long-barreled firearms, as well as 15 handguns, were taken from a secured room within the home.

The homeowner's pickup truck was located by police as it had been abandoned several kilometres north of the residence, however, the firearms, jewelry and other items property taken from the home were not recovered.

Witnesses have reported that a blue newer model pickup truck, jacked up with big tires and a blue tarp in the box, was seen in the area of the residence around the time of the break, enter and theft.

As with any instance wherein firearms have been stolen, police are very concerned for the safety of the public and are interested in hearing from anyone with information regarding this crime.
