## *news release*

FOR IMMEDIATE DISTRIBUTION

On November 21, 2015 Olds RCMP conducted a traffic stop with a vehicle that failed to stop at a stop sign. As a result of the investigation the female driver, Dana PATTERSON from the Sundre area and the male occupant, Clayton RADDIS from the Red Deer area were both arrested for drug offences. The subsequent search of the vehicle resulted in a seizure of 188 grams of marihuana, 25 grams of mushrooms, 50 grams of hash, 12 grams of cocaine, 47 pills of ecstasy, 3 pills of Oxycodone, cash, scales and multiple electronic devices. Both individuals are facing numerous charges including Possession for the Purpose of Trafficking and Possession of a Controlled Substance. RADDIS is facing the additional charges of trafficking in a controlled substance and soliciting the services of a prostitute. PATTERSON is also charged with numerous traffic-related offences. Both individuals were held for a bail hearing where they were released by a Justice of the Peace on bail for court in Didsbury on November 30, 2015.
