

Media Release, Olds Detachment, January 7, 2020

A few unrelated incidents to report on for the first week of the New Year

Incident 1

On December 27, 2019, Olds RCMP received a report that several units in a residential complex in Olds had been broken into. Witnesses later reported to police that they had observed the suspects enter the residences and load several items into a truck and utility trailer. Investigation led the Olds RCMP to obtain a search warrant for a residence in Didsbury. The warrant was executed on January 5th with the assistance of members of the Southern Alberta Crime Reduction Unit and Didsbury RCMP. Several items related to the break and enters were recovered from the residence.

Three individuals were arrested at the scene including Michael Ryan Goodine (43) of Sundre, who has been charged with fourteen offences including Break and Enter, Possession of Stolen Property and Failing to Comply with Release Orders. Goodine was remanded in custody to appear in Didsbury Provincial Court on January 9th. On January 6th, Timothy Michael Doyle (44) of no fixed address, was also arrested by members of the Olds RCMP and Crime Reduction Unit in connection with this Break and Enter Investigation and other property crime matters. He has been charged with Possession of Stolen Property and is set to appear in Didsbury Provincial Court on January 27th.

Incident 2

During the early morning hours of January 3rd, the Olds RCMP received a report of a suspicious motorist broken down east of Olds on Highway 27 near Highway 791. Police arrived to find a male in possession of a Subaru Forester that had been stolen out of Calgary. Daemond Anthony Glenn (27) of Airdrie, was arrested and charged with Possession of Stolen Property. He will appear on that charge on February 24th in Didsbury Provincial Court.

Incident 3

During the evening of January 3rd, Olds RCMP received a complaint of a suspicious vehicle in Bowden. Officers attended and located an unoccupied 2010 Chevrolet Silverado truck and two firearms that had been stolen out of Red Deer. Investigation determined that the male who had been in possession of the truck had entered a residence in Bowden. A warrant was obtained to enter the residence and the driver of the truck was located inside. Brandon Edmond Wegner (29) of Red Deer, was arrested and charged with Possession of Stolen Property and two counts of Breaching a Recognizance. He was remanded in custody to appear on January 6th in Didsbury Provincial Court.

Incident 4

On January 5th at approximately 5:20 AM, the Olds RCMP received a complaint of a suspicious male and vehicle on a rural property southeast of Olds. The male went to the door of the residence and asked the homeowner for gas. The homeowner refused due to the suspicious behaviour of the male and then called the RCMP. The attending officer located a 2005 GMC Sierra on the property that had been stolen out of Airdrie. The officer and local area farmers then tracked the suspect's footprints and found him hiding in a wooded area. David Alfred Matschke (37) of no fixed address, was arrested and charged with Theft and Possession of Stolen Property. Several Calgary arrest warrants were also executed at the time of arrest. Matschke is set to appear in Didsbury Provincial Court on January 20th.
