

## Pump Jack and Oil Lease sites

*March 6, 2017*

A "heads up" on an incident which occurred on a RR east of the city the morning of March 6, 2017 shortly after 8:30 AM. Two RCW members who walk this Range Road with their dogs came across activity in a Pump Jack site. Since there has been a lot of work being done on Pump Jacks in the area, they assumed it was a crew doing maintenance work.

The gate was wide open, with both trucks parked near the Pump Jack. Upon seeing the walkers drive up, they proceeded to leave the site quickly. One being an old 1/2 ton truck (Dodge or Chev) which was loaded with garbage bags and smaller furniture plus a large TV screen. The second truck was a diesel one ton with no markings but had boxes and shelves.

After the trucks left, it was noted the lock had been cut.

Signalta Resources and the RCMP were notified.

The gentleman from Signalta told the caller that they are receiving one to two calls a week regarding "cut" locks and activity within their sites.

Please be vigilant and report any suspicious activity to the RCMP and the company as their contact information is posted on the gates.
