

Post Office Scam, Red Deer/Lacombe RCW

We received this from a friend of mine, asking to make everyone aware:

Today she received an email notification from "Canada Post" telling her that they had a parcel they could not deliver and wanted her to click on the link to print a delivery label.

It looked very legitimate, however, it is shown as Canada Post.com (should be .ca) and there were several grammatical errors in the letter. She called Canada Post and was told they NEVER notify clients by email as they do not have email addresses.

She also noted it was in English only, and being that the Post Office is a federally regulated institution, all correspondence will be in both languages, English and French.
