

Rimbey RCMP – Gas and Dash leads to injured employee

On March 30, 2016 at approximately 2:30 p.m. a gas and dash at the Shell gas station in Rimbey turned dangerous. A male in a white Dodge Ram filled up a slip tank with approximately \$300 worth of fuel and then fled from the gas station without paying. The employee who witnessed this made an effort to stop the truck, which resulted in the employee being dragged on the ground for a short distance. He was transported to a local hospital via Emergency Medical Services where he was treated for minor injuries and released.

The suspect driver is described as:

- Male in his 30s.
- Wearing black sunglasses and blue jeans
- Dyed red Mohawk

The suspect truck is described as:

- White Dodge pick up
- Black sticker stripe package on the hood
- Red slip tank in the back
- Covered in dust and mud

A driving complaint leads the RCMP to believe that this truck was last seen in the area of Highway 20 and Range Road 15A.
