

## **RCMP seeking public's assistance - Armed and Dangerous Suspect at Large**

The Rocky Mountain House RCMP are seeking the public's assistance in locating Keehoo Rick Cardinal. Police say he should be considered armed and dangerous, and ask the public to not approach him but call 911 immediately should he be spotted.

The 35 year old, of no fixed address, is facing nine charges relating to two home invasions that occurred on Boxing Day, including robbery, break and enter, extortion, pointing a fire arm, unlawful confinement, disguise with intent, uttering threats, assault with a weapon and robbery to steal a firearm.



Two others were taken into custody on December 29th, 2017 when police executed search warrants at two different Rocky Mountain House residences, but Keehoo Cardinal remains at large.
