

RCMP St Albert - Warrants for St. Albert Man

April 29, 2016

On April 14, 2016, as a result of a drug investigation, the St. Albert RCMP Drug Section conducted a drug search warrant on a residence in Heritage Lakes in St. Albert. As a result of that search, the RCMP seized:

- approximately 2 ounces of cocaine,
- over 3 pounds of marijuana,
- multiple ounces of THC resin – commonly known as “shatter” on the street,
- hundreds of pills packaged for illicit sale. The pills still have to be analyzed to determine which drugs they contain.
- A stolen grey 2009 GMC Sierra truck, and
- A stolen red 2008 Honda quad.

A 22 year old female resident of St. Albert was arrested at the scene of the Search Warrant and is facing pending charges.

Bradley Thomas Cooper, age 37, of St. Albert, Alberta has been charged with several crimes including Possession of Drugs for the Purpose of Trafficking and Possession of Stolen Property. Mr. Cooper has not been located and a warrant for his arrest has been issued. He already has outstanding warrants from Edmonton and St. Albert for previous alleged violence related charges including Aggravated Assault and Assault with a Weapon.

St. Albert RCMP is looking for your help on these crimes.
