

Sundre Community Van Society Treasurer Arrested

On July 10, 2018, the Sundre RCMP detachment received a complaint from the Sundre Community Van Society regarding the fraudulent use of its funds by its Treasurer. The Society, which provides seniors' transportation for appointments, events and amenity needs, reported that approximately \$6,300 was spent by its treasurer on unauthorized purchases such as personal payments, cell phone bills and fuel between April and June of this year.

On July 31, 2018 Robin Strub (30) of Caroline, AB was arrested and charged with Section 336CC - Criminal Breach of Trust. She was released by a Justice of the Peace to appear in Provincial Court in Didsbury, AB on August 13, 2018 to speak to the matter.

"Unfortunately this is a solemn reminder that there are individuals out there that prey on the good trusting nature of our seniors and the organizations that assist them. I am glad that the RCMP Sundre detachment was able to assist the Society to hold Ms. Strub accountable for her alleged actions," said Cpl Joe Mandel.
