

## Sundre RCMP Request The Public's Assistance

On December 28, 2018 at approximately 9:00pm, Sundre RCMP received a complaint of a suspicious vehicle parked at the Fountain Tire in Sundre, Alberta. A dark blue F150 pickup truck was witnessed earlier driving aggressively and its two occupants acting odd. When police attended the Fountain Tire, the vehicle immediately fled the area. Police attempted to block their escape from the parking lot but the truck struck one of the police vehicles and pushed its way past into the ditch. The truck was able to get onto Hwy 27 and head east where it turned off its lights to further evade capture.



Police pursued the truck where it turned south onto Hwy 22 but police but lost sight of the vehicle south of the Hwy 582. Police are requesting the assistance of the public to help identify the truck and its occupants. The truck will have damage to the lower portion of the driver's side door from pushing past the police vehicle.



The truck can be described as:

- 2014-2015 dark blue Ford F150 XTR;
- Large antenna on the top of the cab;
- Mudflaps with a chrome Ford emblem;
- Dark coloured wheels;
- Damage to the lower portion of the driver's side door.

The driver can be described as:

- Caucasian male in his 20s;
- Dark ball cap;
- Dark sweater;
- Dark coloured pants;
- Wearing a light coloured jacket with dark horizontal stripes.



The passenger can be described as:

- Caucasian female in her early 20s;
- Dark hair;
- Dark coloured jacket;

- Light coloured sweater;
- Light coloured pants with dark coloured mukluk style boots.
