

Suspicious Trio Arrested Without Incident

On July 14, 2019, the Sundre RCMP received a report from several citizens of three suspicious people near the Red Deer river south of Range Road 61 and Secondary Hwy 584. The citizens were quadding in the area when they came across an adult female and two adult males attempting to get a white pickup truck out of the mud. The trio fled the area when they were seen by the citizens. One male fled on a quad and was witnessed to be in possession of a firearm, which he subsequently dropped in the water, while fleeing when he momentarily lost control of the quad. The citizens seized the firearm and later provided it to police when they arrived. The trio were later witnessed leaving the area in a red pickup truck. Police located the truck and trio attempting to hide at rural property. All three were arrested without incident with two of them holding several outstanding arrest warrants. The trio were charged accordingly for a variety of offences related to this incident and were held to appear before a Justice of the Peace for a judicial interim release hearing.

Mr. Goodine and Mr. Burns were remanded into custody to speak to their matter at a later date. Ms. Petersen was released on \$5000 No Cash bail with court imposed conditions to appear in Didsbury Provincial Court on August 12, 2019.

"These three individuals are known to police for their continued criminality in the Sundre, Olds and Didsbury detachment areas. In this instance, a keen eye by the public greatly assisted in getting two of these individuals off of the street for the interim. My hope is that this continued and combined oversight by the public and local police will keep individuals like these uncomfortably accountable either through incarceration, rehabilitation or their eventual relocation." - Cpl Joe Mandel
