

Daytime Prowler Nabbed

On July 17, 2019 at approximately 7:00 PM, RCMP Sundre were called to a residence in the Town of Sundre for a Break and Enter. The homeowner reported that his house was broken into a few hours prior while his 13 year-old and 10 year-old sons were home. The suspect knocked on the front door and when there was no answer, the suspect went around the house and smashed out a basement window to gain access. The unknown male went through the home taking what he could put in his pockets but quickly departed when he saw the two boys attempting to hide in their rooms. The boys were initially frightened but unharmed in the matter. The incident was captured on security cameras and the male was immediately identified by police and was located and arrested. The male was charged with two criminal offences and subsequently released to appear in Didsbury Provincial court on August 19, 2019.
