

Three Hills RCMP execute search warrant and charge male with multiple offences

On Jan. 3, 2019, Three Hills RCMP along with RCMP Emergency Response Team, and the Southern Alberta Crime Reduction Unit, conducted a search warrant on a residence just north of Trochu, Alberta.

Alfred Legacy (57) of Kneehill County, Alta., has been charged with:

- Obstruction
- Fail to comply with Undertaking
- Occupant of a motor vehicle with a firearm
- Transporting a firearm carelessly
- Carrying a concealed weapon
- Possession of stolen property under \$5000
- Flight from police
- Possession of a weapon for a dangerous purpose (X2)

He was released from custody on his own recognizance, and will be appearing in Drumheller Provincial Court on Jan. 25, 2019

Police seized a large amount of electronics and oilfield property that was located at the residence and are still attempting to identify the property owners.
